Morse Museum presents the SaskTel Centennial Exhibit

The Museum Association of Saskatchewan and SaskTel have teamed up to celebrate SaskTel's 100th Anniversary with a travelling exhibit. Morse Museum has been chosen as one of only twelve museums to host the display.

The exhibit explores how the telephone system helped connect the people of Saskatchewan, the community spirit behind the development of the system, and the way in which SaskTel continues to connect citizens of Saskatchewan with each other.
